

RAYTOWN POSTAL CARRIER ALERT

How the program works ...

The Raytown Police and the Raytown branch of the U.S. Postal Service have joined in a cooperative effort to offer Raytown residents the Carrier Alert program. Designed primarily for the elderly and handicapped who live alone, Carrier Alert is available free of charge to area residents who live alone in Raytown. Carrier Alert can offer the peace of mind that someone who visits your home regularly, your letter carrier, will call for help if it appears you need it. To participate in this program, residents that qualify are asked to complete the application in this pamphlet. This form is kept on file by the Raytown Police Department. As a registered Carrier Alert member, a bright pink sticker will be affixed on the inside of your mailbox. If your letter carrier sees that there are two days of uncollected mail in your mailbox, or any other signs that might suggest you're in distress, the letter carrier will contact the Raytown Police Department. A police officer will then investigate, and if necessary, contact the proper medical emergency personnel and the contacts listed on this registration form.

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITY

Applicants must complete the Carrier Alert application form, including the names and phone numbers of two persons who can be contacted in the event that officers need to enter your home.

Members must check their mailbox and remove mail daily to avoid alarming your letter carrier unnecessarily.

Have someone pick up your mail or notify your letter carrier if you know you will be away from home for more than one day. Also notify the Raytown Police Department by calling (816) 737-6187.

Notify your letter carrier or call Carrier Alert Coordinator at the Raytown Police Department at (816) 737-6187 if you move or choose to discontinue your membership in the Carrier Alert program.

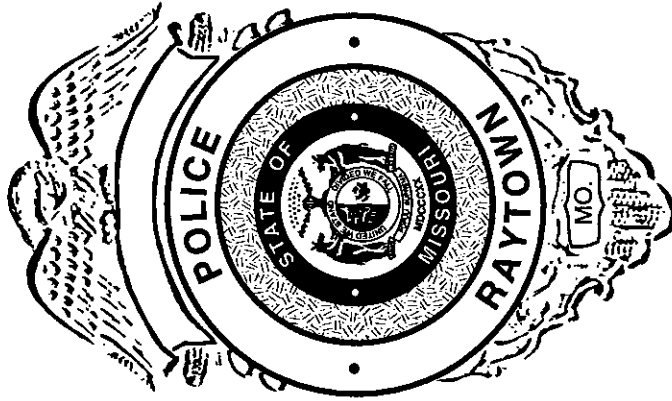
